M.Tech. (Self-financed) Admission: Written Test & Interview - August 2021

Instructions to Shortlisted Candidates

- 1. Please make sure that you have a computer (Laptop or Desktop) with camera and microphone facility and a smart phone fully charged for the entire duration of written test/interview. You are advised to take the written test only on a desktop or laptop.
- 2. Please make sure that your internet connection is good with a proper bandwidth. NITK is not responsible for any interruption of network connections during the test/interview. During the written test, you should not make or attend any phone calls.
- 3. The written test (online) will be conducted on *Moodle* platform through *IRIS* portal of NITK. The login credentials are the same as the one you used for submitting your application. In addition, you will be required to login through *Microsoft Teams* for showing your face clearly for the full duration of the written test (proctoring purpose). You are advised to install *Microsoft Teams* on your computer, and familiarise yourself with it.
- 4. A *Microsoft Teams* link will be sent to your email address for the written test. You can log into *Microsoft Teams* by typing your <u>Application Number</u> followed by your <u>Full Name</u> as given in your Application as User Name, and then click to *Join the Meeting*.
- 5. During the written test/interview, you should be the only person present in the room/cabin. Make sure that the place is well lit with sufficient light falling on your face from the front. Avoid modifying or blurring the backgrounds.
- 6. The written test will be proctored and recorded by us. Applicants resorting to any kind of malpractice or indulge in misconduct during the test/interview may be expelled from the selection process.
- 7. The written test will start at 9.00 am on 30.08.2021, and you are advised to login to the IRIS portal by 8:45 am. Duration of the written test is 90 minutes for 100 questions. The questions should be answered sequentially, which means they cannot be revisited. All questions carry one mark each, unanswered questions will carry zero marks, and the wrong answers will carry a negative mark of 0.25.
- 8. Applicants who have applied in the multiple streams (EN/GT/ST/TS) will have to appear in a common test only. The syllabus is similar to that of GATE 2021 (Civil Engineering).
- 9. Shortlisted candidates for the interview will be published on the website after the written test. Only those candidates who qualify after the written test will be allowed for the interview.
- 10. The interview for the shortlisted candidates will be conducted from 2:00 pm onwards on 30.08.2021 through *Microsoft Teams* platform. The interview may extend to the next day (31.08.2021).
- 11. A separate *Microsoft Teams* link will be sent to the shortlisted candidates. You are required to login at the start of the allotted time slot and wait in the lobby until your turn for the interview. You will be admitted only when it is your turn for the interview.
- 12. Your interview can last between 5 and 15 minutes. Once your interview is over, the interview committee will log you out.
