**Instructions to the candidates:**

B.Tech. classes would commence from 14<sup>th</sup> November 2022. The orientation programmes will be held from 10<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

The schedule for the orientation programme will be notified soon.

The Academic calendar will be made available soon in the website.

The hostel allotments will be done at the time of physical reporting . The candidates may come prepared to stay in the hostel soon after the admission formalities. Mess facility will be available from the date of reporting to the Hostel.

Candidates are advised to fill their details through the NITK IRIS portal on clicking the MIS link and pay the prescribed Institute's fee / Hostel's Fee mentioned below before final physical reporting for admission to the institute. (If it is not possible to fill-in the details before reaching NITK, arrangements will be made to use the computer facilities at NITK.)

Hostellers are required to pay the applicable mess fee at the time of admission to the Hostel. The mess fee is **Rs.32,100/-** for first semester.

**Tuition Fee Waiver for B. Tech Students**

- \* Students belonging to General , GEN-EWS & OBC-NCL category whose family income is less than Rs.1.00 lakh per annum shall get full remission of Tuition fees (Rs.62500/-) on submission of latest income certificate from the revenue authorities not below the rank of Tehsildar issued on or after 1.4.2022.
- \* Students belonging to General , GEN-EWS & OBC-NCL category whose family income is between Rs.1.00 lakh to Rs.5.00 lakh per annum shall get remission of 2/3rd of the Tuition fees (Rs.41667/-) on submission of latest income certificate from the revenue authorities not below the rank of Tehsildar issued on or after 1.4.2022.
- \* Students belonging to SC/ST/PwD category are exempted from the payment of Tuition fee. (No Income certificate is to be submitted)
- \* **The students have to pay the full fees of first semester during the admission time. For refund of tuition fee for eligible candidates, the circular in this regard will be issued to submit family's income certificate issued on or after 1.4.2022 after completion of UG admission.**
- \* Those who need fee remission for upcoming academic years need to submit the income certificate issued in that financial year.

**The following documents to be uploaded in the IRIS portal and original along with two photocopies to be submitted for verification during physical reporting for admission.**

1. Application form downloaded from the IRIS portal.
2. Provisional admission letter downloaded from the JoSAA/CSAB portal
3. Score Card of JEE (Main)
4. Admit Card of JEE (Main)
5. Original Certificate of Date of Birth issued by competent authority/Class X (High School) Board Certificate as proof of date of birth
6. Original Mark sheet of Class XII
7. Original Certificate of category (OBC-NCL/SC/ST), if applicable, as per Government of India, issued by the competent authority. In case of OBC category, the certificate must be issued on or after April 1, 2022.
8. OBC Undertaking in the format available in NITK Website
9. Original Income and Asset Certificate for EWS candidates, if applicable, as per Government of India, issued by the competent authority. The certificate must be issued on or after April 1, 2022.
10. Original Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PWD), if applicable, issued by the competent authority and the physical verification report issued by any verifying center during JoSAA Rounds.
11. Original Migration certificate of last institute/university attended (If from outside Karnataka)
12. Original Conduct/Character Certificate from head of the institution last attended
13. Original Transfer certificate from the head of the institution last attended
14. Medical Fitness Certificate. (JoSAA format / NITK format)
15. Photo ID proof as per Govt. of India norms (Copy of Aadhar Card is compulsory)
16. Passport size photograph.

(If any certificate is in language other than Hindi or English or Kannada, translation of the same in English is to be produced with certification by the competent authority).

**Important Note:**

- (1) Candidates belonging to OBC –NCL or EWS category are required to submit the certificates in the prescribed format available in the NITK website (i.e. [www.nitk.ac.in](http://www.nitk.ac.in)) or in JoSAA portal and issued on or after April 1, 2022
- (2) Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL) issued by Maharashtra State must be validated by Social Welfare department (in case of SC and OBC-NCL category) and Tribal Welfare department (in case of ST category) of Maharashtra Government. The SC/ST/OBC-NCL candidates of Maharashtra State have to produce their caste validity certificate in the format available in the NITK website (i.e. [www.nitk.ac.in](http://www.nitk.ac.in)).
- (3) The candidates who belong to PWD category must submit the certificate issued from a competent authority in the prescribed format.
