ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The IEEE PES India Scholarship Award (IPISA) is an initiative of IEEE Power & Energy Society (PES) and IEEE Foundation, facilitated by IEEE India Philanthropy. The scholarship aims to encourage talented students to pursue careers in Electrical Engineering and Power & Energy domains while supporting deserving students from diverse socio-economic backgrounds across India.

OFFERING OF IPISA SCHOLARSHIP 2026

The IEEE PES India Scholarship Award (IPISA) supports selected students throughout their 2nd, 3rd, and 4th years of engineering, subject to annual renewal and satisfactory academic performance.

Each selected scholar will receive:

- ₹50,000 per year towards college and hostel fees.
- Up to ₹25,000 per year towards participation in approved IEEE/PES conferences, workshops, seminars, internships, tutorials, and professional development activities.
- Mentorship support from IEEE PES professionals, volunteers, and industry experts.
- Access to two IEEE Blended Learning Platform (BLP) technical courses every year at no additional cost.
- Opportunities to engage with the IEEE and PES community through technical events, networking, and professional development activities.

WHO CAN APPLY

- Students pursuing **Second Year** B.E./B. Tech. in Electrical Engineering (EE) or Electrical & Electronics Engineering (EEE) only.
- Must be a full-time undergraduate student enrolled in an AICTE/UGC-recognized institution.
- Must have secured:
 - Minimum 60% marks (or equivalent CGPA) in Class XII/qualifying examination.
 - First Class or equivalent CGPA in the first year of engineering.
- Must possess a valid rank in: JEE Main, JEE Advanced, or State-level Engineering Entrance Examination
- Must hold a valid IEEE Student Membership and IEEE PES Student Membership at the time of application.
- Preference will be given to students demonstrating financial need and challenging socio-economic conditions.
