Description:

Summer Mentorship Programmes (SMPs) are an important aspect of our club and are held every year over the summer, from May to June. This programme gives the students from NITK an opportunity to enhance their knowledge and/or skills in a wide range of topics over the course of 1-2 months. SMPs are typically conducted by the members of IE NITK, particularly the pre-final year students. This year, we witnessed a large number of participants, around 240+ students from both the sophomore as well as pre-final years of B.Tech.

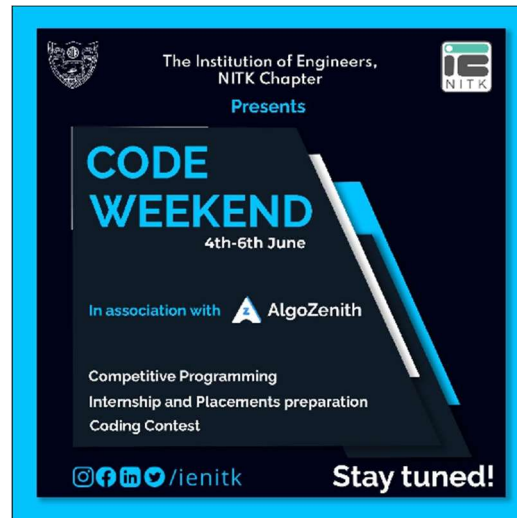
Code Weekend- Collab with Algozenith:

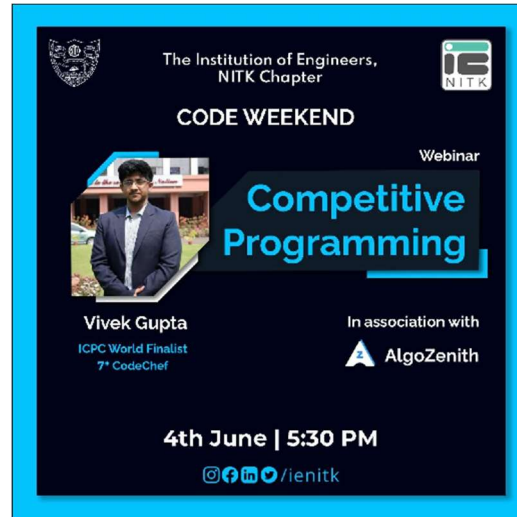

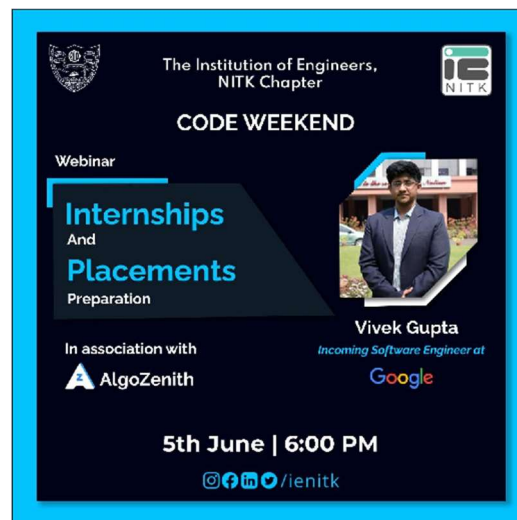

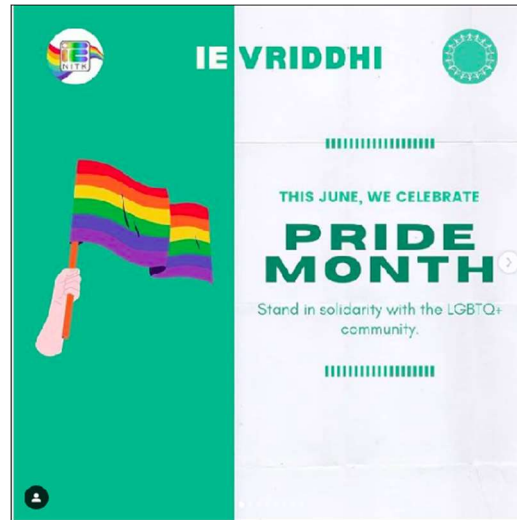
